Please find attached your Manager's Certificate, duly granted by the Taupō District Licensing Committee.

I wish to draw your attention to Section 214 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 which states:

214 Manager to be on duty at all times and responsible for compliance

- (1) Except as provided in Section 215, a manager must be on duty at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied to the public on any licensed premises.
- (2) A manager on duty on any licensed premises is responsible for-
 - (a) the compliance with and enforcement of—
 - (i) the provisions of this Act; and
 - (ii) the conditions of the licence in force for the premises; and
 - (b) the conduct of the premises with the aim of contributing to the reduction of alcohol-related harm.
- (3) At all times while a manager is on duty on any licensed premises, the full name of the manager must be prominently displayed inside the premises so as to be easily read by people using the premises; and the person named as manager at any time is to be treated for the purposes of this Act as the manager at that time.
- (4) At all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied on licensed premises the licensee must take all reasonable steps to enable the manager to comply with this section.

Your Manager's Certificate **does not** need to be displayed in a licensed premises but must be available for viewing by the Police or a Licensing Inspector.

This is an application by **Timothy John Burke** for a Managers Certificate pursuant to Section 219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 12th November 2018.

Section 217 - Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Timothy John Burke

Certificate Number: 20/CERT/2398/2018

is authorised to manage any licensed premises in respect of which a licence is in force.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to fees and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of manager's certificates, this certificate shall continue in force:

- a) Either:
 - 1. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - 2. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of twelve months after the day it was issued; but
- b) If an application for the renewal of the certificate is duly made before the certificate would otherwise expire, either:
 - 1. Until the close of the period of three years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - 2. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of four years after the day it was issued.

This certificate expires on 14 December 2019 if not renewed.
