**IN THE MATTER** of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act)

## **AND**

**IN THE MATTER** of an application by Lake Local Liquor Limited for a new OFF Licence pursuant to Section 100 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 in respect of the premises situated at 3 Mapou Road, Taupo and known as "Lake Local Liquor"

## THE APPLICATION:

This is an application by Lake Local Liquor Limited for an Off Licence in respect of premises situated at 3 Mapou Road, Taupo, known as "Lake Local Liquor". It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 7th September 2020. The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of Remote Sales.

The application was duly advertised in the Taupo & Turangi Weekender newspaper on 17<sup>th</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Display of the public notice has been carried out in the terms of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the licensee and no objections were lodged by any members of the public.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION:**

The applicant has sought a Section 40 Remote Seller of alcohol OFF Licence. Alcohol can <u>only</u> be sold under this licence and delivered to the customer elsewhere, for consumption off the premises. At least 85% of the annual income of the business must be derived from the sale of alcohol.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health reports raise no matters in opposition.

### THE DECISION:

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in the Act and we grant the applicant an Off Licence authorising to sell or deliver alcohol from the premises situated at 3 Mapou Road, Taupo, and known as Lake Local Liquor, to any person for consumption off the premises.

The licence shall be subjected to specific conditions as detailed in the attached licence.

#### **OFF LICENCE**

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, <u>Lake Local Liquor Limited</u> is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol from the premises situated at 3 Mapou Road, Taupo, and known as Lake Local, to any person for consumption off the premises.

# **ENDORSEMENT**

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else. The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager, or managers, appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## **CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol may be sold from the premises at any time on any day and delivered somewhere else for consumption off the premises only on the following days and hours as set out in condition (3) of this licence;
- 2. No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day;
- 3. No alcohol is to be delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11.00pm on any day and before 6.00am on the next day;
- 4. The licensee must follow the procedures set out in Regulation 14 & 15 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 to ensure that neither the purchaser nor the person to whom alcohol is delivered is a minor;
- 5. There must be a certificated manager properly appointed to the business by the licensee.
- 6. The licensee must display on its website and/or in its catalogue and on every receipt issued for alcohol sold remotely:
  - the licence holder's name and licence number,
  - · the date on which the licence expires,
  - a legible image of the licence or a clearly identified link to such an image.

# THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale, supply or consumption of alcohol is authorised in the premises generally. The premises situated at 3 Mapou Road, Rainbow Point, Taupo, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 4 September 2020.

## **DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was renewed.

This licence expires on 15 October 2021 unless further renewed
