THE APPLICATION:

This is an application by Taupo Distilling Limited for an Off Licence in respect of premises situated at 2 Pukenamu Road, Taupo, known as "Taupo Distilling Co". It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 12th January 2022. The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of Remote OFF Sales of alcohol.

The application was duly advertised in the Taupo & Turangi Weekender newspaper on 20 January 2022 & 27 January 2022 and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Display of the public notice has been carried out in the terms of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the licensee and no objections were lodged by any members of the public.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION:

The applicant appears to be a suitable entity and a certificated manager is appointed to this low risk activity.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health reports raise no matters in opposition.

THE DECISION:

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in the Act and we grant the applicant an Off Licence authorising to sell or deliver alcohol from the premises situated at 2 Pukenamu Road, Taupo, and known as Taupo Distilling Co, to any person for consumption off the premises.

The licence shall be subjected to specific conditions as detailed in the attached licence.

OFF LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, <u>Taupo Distilling Limited</u> is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol from the premises situated at 2 Pukenamu Road, Taupo, and known as Taupo Distilling Co, to any person for consumption off the premises.

ENDORSEMENT

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager, or managers, appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol may be sold from the premises at any time on any day, and delivered somewhere else for consumption off the premises, only on the following days and hours:
 - Monday to Friday from 8.00am to 5.00pm.
- 2. No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- 3. No alcohol is to be delivered to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time between 11.00pm and 6.00am the following day, on any day of the week.
- 4. There must be a certificated manager properly appointed to the business by the licensee.
- 5. The licensee must follow the procedures set out in Regulations 14 & 15 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013, to ensure that neither the purchaser nor the person to whom alcohol is delivered to is a minor.
- 6. The licensee must state the licensee's name, the licence number and the date the licence expires:
 - a. on every receipt issued for alcohol sold remotely,
 - b. in every catalogue, if alcohol is sold by remote sale using catalogues,
 - c. on the internet site, if alcohol is sold by remote sale using an internet site,
 - d. if alcohol is sold by remote sale using an internet site, the site must also display either a legible image of the licence, or a clearly identified link to such an image.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised in of from the premises generally. The premises situated at 2 Pukenamu Road, Rainbow Point, Taupo, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 12 January 2022.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was renewed.

This licence expires on 8 April 2023 unless further renewed
