The Application:

This is an application by TMGH Jolly Limited Partnership for an On Licence for Conveyance in respect of vessel based at and journeying on Lake Taupo, known as "Waikare II". It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 12th November 2019. The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of Conveyance (Boat).

The application was duly advertised in the Taupo Times newspaper on 15th and 22nd of November 2019 and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Display of the public notice has been carried out in the terms of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the licensee and no objections were lodged by any members of the public.

The Reasons for the Decision:

The application comes about following a company reshulffle with a new entity and shareholdings. The day to day operations will remain unchanged.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health reports raise no matters in opposition.

The Decision:

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in the Act and we grant the applicant an On Licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the conveyance, to any person present on the vessel and to allow the consumption of liquor on the conveyance by any such person.

The licence shall be subjected to specific conditions as detailed in the attached licence.

ON-LICENCE

(for Conveyance)

Sections 14 to 16 and 64 of the Sale and Supply of Alochol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, <u>TMGH JOLLY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP</u> is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the vessel known as "Waikare II" based at Taupo Boat Harbour, Taupo, and journeying on Lake Taupo, to any person present on the vessel and to allow the consumption of alcohol on the conveyance by any such person.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the vessel only on the following days and hours: During the period of any scheduled cruise, but not other than on the following days & hours: Monday to Sunday from 8.00am to 2.00am the following day.
- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the vessel.
- 3. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the vessel, at all times when the vessel is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the vessel at all times the vessel is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible and food should be actively promoted.
- 5. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the vessel is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the vessel.
- 6. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed vessel.
- 7. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the vessel so as to be easily read by patrons.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale, supply or consumption of alcohol is authorised on the vessel generally. The premises based at Taupo Boat Harbour, Redoubt Street, Taupo, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 12 November 2019.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The principal entrance is accessed from the bow of the vessel.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was renewed.

This licence expires on 30 January 2021 unless further renewed
