CLUB LICENCE

Sections 21 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 <u>TAUPO DARTS ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED</u> is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **27 A C Baths Avenue**, **Taupo** and known as **Taupo Darts Association**, for consumption on the premises, to any person who-

- a) is a member of the club; or
- b) is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
- c) is a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members; or
- d) is on the premises at the invitation of an authorised visitor who is also on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the club in accordance with Sub-Part 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: Mondays from 11.00am to 12.00 midnight; Tuesdays to Thursdays from 4.00pm to 12.00 midnight; and Fridays to Sundays from 9.00am to 1.00am the following day.
- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 3. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
- 5. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
- 7. Whilst the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol no BYO alcohol may be consumed on the premises.
- 8. The Club must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons.
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read so as to be easily read by persons using the premises.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale, supply or consumption of alcohol is authorised in the premises generally. The premises situated at 27 A C Baths Avenue, Taupo, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Liquor Licensing Authority on 12 December 1991.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from the carpark at 27 A C Baths Avenue is designated as the principal entrance.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on: **12 December 2022**
