The Application

This is an application by **Beehave Meadery Limited** for an Off-Site Special Licence pursuant to Section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for the **Market Central**. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 20th October 2020.

Reasons for the Decision

The applicant appears to be a suitable entity to hold a Special licence and certificated managers will oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

The reports of the Police and the Medical Officer of Health do not oppose this application.

The Decision

I am satisfied that the criteria of Section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 have been satisfactorily addressed by the applicant and the licence may issue subject to the following conditions:

- Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours: Every Sunday from 29 November 2020 to 7 March 2021; from 8.00am to 1.00pm on each date.
- 2. While alcohol is being supplied as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
- 3. A maximum of four samples can be provided in 15 to 25 ml sample sizes, and that samples are to be limited to one of each per customer.
- 4. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the stall.

5. The Licensee must display:

- a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
- b. If so directed a copy of the licence is to be attached to the stall so as to be easily read by people attending the licensed area (site number A15).

The licensed premises known as The Beehave Meadery @ Market Central (site number A15) situated at the Northcroft Reserve, Northcroft Street, Taupo, is more precisely identified as outlined in the event site plan provided with the application, as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 20 October 2020.

Section 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012
