Off Site Special Licence

Section 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Dean Richard Fleming** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at Northcroft Reserve, Northcroft Street, Taupo and known as Market Central for consumption off the premises, to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **Market Central.**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a managers or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: Sunday 25 February 2024 from 9.00am to 1.00pm.
- 2. The licensed area being a 3m x3m open-air stall, shall be designated as a Supervised area, as identified on the site plan date stamped as received by Taupo District Licensing Committee on 31 January 2024.
- 3. While alcohol is being supplied as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
- 4. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
- 5. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
 - b. If so directed a copy of the licence is to be attached to stall so as to be easily read by people attending the licensed area.

DURATION

This licence is only in force as specified in Condition 1.
