This is an application by **Café Pinot Limited** for a Temporary Authority for premises situated at 56 Huka Falls Road, Taupo known as "Café Pinot."

There is a substantive ON licence in place 20/ON/0247/2017 that expires on the 19<sup>th</sup> of May 2020.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence indicating that a lease agreement has been completed for the business.

Accordingly, the application is to be dealt with by the committee on the papers.

## REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order.

An application to vary the licensed area of the Huka Falls Resort complex to provide a separate premises for this applicant is in progress.

We remind the applicant that a properly appointed certificated, or Acting or Temporary Manager <u>must be on duty at all times</u> the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.

## **DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act has been met.

Section 136(5) of the Act says the person authorised by the order has for the purposes of this Act the same duties, obligations, and liabilities as the holder of the on-licence or off-licence concerned.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority ON Licence with the existing conditions on the base licence continuing to apply:

- The Order is to run for 3 months from the 14th of November 2019;
- The substantive ON Licence application must be lodged within 5 working days of receiving the planning certificate.
