This is an application by Ruapehu Food Warehouse Limited for a Temporary Authority for premises situated at 131 Ruapehu Street, Taupo known as "Pak N Save Taupo."

There is a substantive OFF Licence 20/OFF/0065/2016 expiring on the 30th of August 2019. Takeover date is scheduled to be on 18 February 2019.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence indicating that a lease and sale and purchase agreement have been completed for the business.

Accordingly, the application is to be dealt with by the committee on the papers.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order.

The existing complement of certificated managers and staff are to be kept on by the new owner.

DECISION

The application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act has been met.

Section 136(5) of the Act says the person authorised by the order has for the purposes of this Act the same duties, obligations, and liabilities as the holder of the on-licence or off-licence concerned.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority OFF Licence with the existing conditions on the base licence continuing to apply:

- The Order is to run for 3 months from the 18th of February 2019;
- The substantive OFF Licence application must be lodged within 5 days of receiving the planning certificate from council.
