NOTIFICATION OF PARTS OF PLAN CHANGE 20 TO THE TAUPO DISTRICT PLAN BECOMING OPERATIVE

The following parts of Plan Change 20 to the Taupo District Plan was approved by resolution of the Taupo District Council pursuant to Clause 17 of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991 on 26 February 2008.

Those parts of Plan Change 20 to become operative are Objectives 3a.2.2 and 3a.2.4 and associated policies and explanations, Rule 4e.1.7 and associated matters of assessment, Rule 4e.1.8 and the following assessment criteria x, District Planning Maps A13, B16, B17, B18, B21, B24, C6, C9, C13, C14, C15, C17, C18, C19, C20, C22, C23, C24, C25, C36, C37.

In accordance with Clause 20 of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991, Taupo District Council gives notice that the above mentioned sections and maps of the Taupo District Plan shall become operative in full on 7 March 2008.

It should be noted that two appeals have been made on decisions released on Plan Change 20 but given their restricted scope, they have not prevented the sections above from becoming operative.
