How do we foster pride?

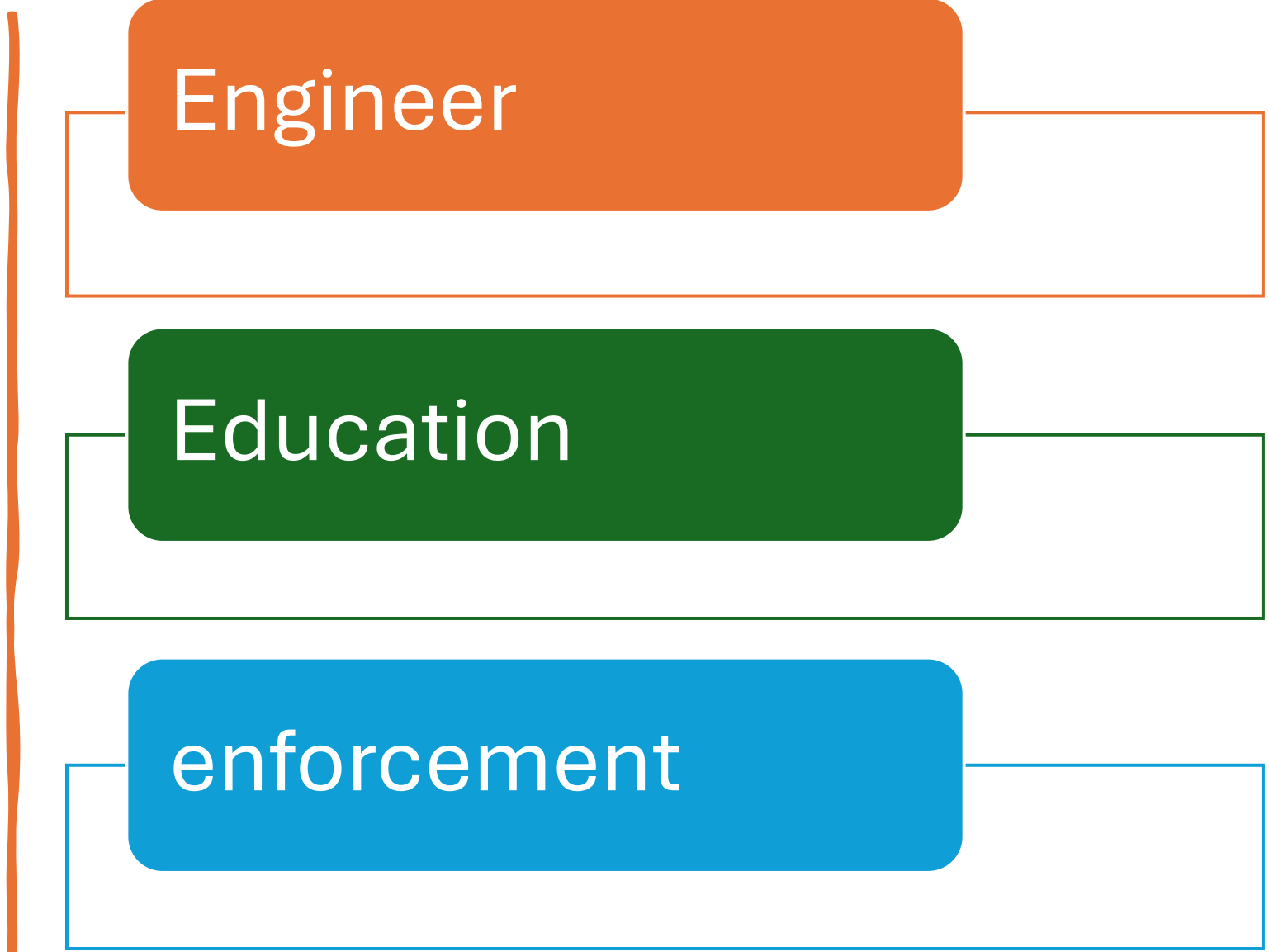
Effect is more than just cost – damage to playing fields, potential loss of events at the park
