General

- 1.—New Zealand Transport Agency ("the Requiring Authority") is the Requiring Authority responsible for the designation:
- 2.—The Proposed Work consists of the construction, operation and maintenance of an arterial road from State Highway 1 at Wairakei, crossing the Waikato River over a new bridge, through a route to the east of Taupō township and rejoining State Highway 1 south of Richmond Heights in the vicinity of 3 Mile Bay and all associated works and activities:
- 3.—The scope and extent of the works envisaged within the designation shall be generally in accordance with the Notice of Requirement and the supporting "*East Taupō Arterial "Assessment of Environmental Effects"*" (AEE) June 2002, as amended by the Requiring Authority at the hearing in relation to the reduction of land needed for the Broadlands Road intersection and subject to the Outline Plan, the conditions set out below and the minor alterations and associated plans dated 05/04/07, referenced as *Alteration to Designation Plan: Sheets 1 to 6, Sheets 1000 to 1005* and formally approved on the 11th July 2007.

Outline Plan

- 4.—Before any construction is commenced, information and plans (the Outline Plan) shall be submitted in terms of section 176A of the Resource Management Act 1991 to the Chief Executive of the Taupō District Council or their nominee (hereinafter referred to as the "Council"). The Outline Plan shall show those matters required to be included by section 176A of the Act, provide for those matters specified in all of the following conditions and be in general accordance with the AEE. For the absence of doubt, the Outline Plan includes all other management and mitigation plans referred to in these conditions and may be prepared in stages as appropriate:
- 5.—The Council shall nominate a person or persons who have the requisite skill and expertise to review the Outline Plan and certify that it complies with the conditions of this designation and the Requiring Authority shall not commence construction of the proposed work until:
 - The Outline Plan; or
 - That part of the Outline Plan submitted in respect of a specified stage of the Proposed Work has been certified:has been so certified:

Design Details

6.—Subject to the express conditions set out elsewhere, the Outline Plan shall include the following design details:

- The location of the proposed road carriageway in relation to the designation boundaries;
- The location of all intersections, culverts, bridges (including the Waikato River bridge), underpasses, overpasses, and ancillary roads;
- The extent, location and nature of major earthworks;
- The general location and design of all acoustic bunds, barriers, and vegetative screens;
- The location and design of silt control structures;
- Landscaping proposed including details of landscape planting, re-vegetation of disturbed areas, and treatment of cut and fill batters;
- The location and details of proposed planting and mitigation measures for geothermal features;
- Ecological mitigation works;
- The programme for the carrying out of the proposed work (including staging details if applicable);

Detailed design plans for the new Waikato River bridge ("the Bridge") shall be provided including:

- The length of the bridge.
- The width of the carriageway and traffic lanes.
- Separated pedestrian walkway.
- Adequate provision for bicycles.
- The location of piers.
- The location of any services or utilities, including steam and geothermal water pipes if provided.

7.—In recognition that the final design of the Bridge will be subject to separate resource consent applications to Environment Waikato, the following shall apply in respect of the final design and appearance of the Bridge:

- The Bridge, unless authorised by a resource consent issued by Environment Waikato and following consultation with tangata whenua, shall not incorporate any piers within the channel of the Waikato River.
- The Bridge shall be designed and constructed to provide a minimum clearance of at least 3.5 metres from the maximum permitted flow of the Waikato River.
- The Bridge shall be designed and constructed to ensure that, as far as is practicable, its length, bulk, profile and visual effects are minimised.

Property Management and Liaison

8.—Any land taken or held for the works shall be maintained to a reasonable standard until physical works commence.

9.—The Requiring Authority shall ensure that all reasonable steps are taken to prevent any nuisance and damage to adjacent properties during construction.

10.—Fences removed as a result of this project shall be reinstated at the Requiring Authority's expense unless alternative arrangements have been made with the affected landowner.

11.—At all times reasonable physical vehicular and pedestrian access shall be maintained to private properties not directly affected by construction works in the area affected. Where private properties are directly affected by construction causing vehicular access to be temporarily prevented and no alternative can be utilised, the Requiring Authority shall ensure that the property owner and occupier if relevant, is consulted with respect to the most suitable time for carrying out the work and the Requiring Authority shall minimise the period during which access is prevented.

12.—The Requiring Authority shall at all times, from the date that works commence in each stage, ensure that all affected landowners and residents are able to contact a site manager(s) who will be available at all reasonable times and upon reasonable notice to liaise with all parties over concerns arising from the undertaking of the proposed works. This person shall be appointed prior to the commencement of

works in that stage and contact details for the site manager shall be advised to affected owners/occupiers and on a large notice board at each end of the works.

13. All contract documentation for physical works shall include copies of the designation conditions, any other resource consents (including conditions) and approved or Outline Plan(s) held for the project. This documentation is to be held at all site offices.

14. The Requiring Authority shall establish contingency measures to address any incidence of non-compliance with these conditions and develop procedures for handling complaints.

Work Hours

15. Construction ~~adjacent to residentially zoned areas~~ shall be limited to the following hours:

Monday to Saturday ——— 7.00 am to 7.00 pm

Sunday and Public Holidays — No work

Daylight hours in all other areas

Emergency work is allowed beyond these times. Emergency work includes such activities as dust control of construction areas, drainage and ponding maintenance, temporary intersection, or private access work or traffic flow requirements.

This condition is subject to ~~Conditions 32 to 34 on construction noise.~~

Cultural Matters

16. In the event that koiwi, taonga or other artefact material is discovered in any area, or archaeological sites are discovered or are reasonably suspected to have been unearthed during the construction of the road, the Requiring Authority shall ensure that the *Archaeological Site and Cultural Protocols for Road Construction* attached as Schedule “A” to these conditions are complied with.

17. The Requiring Authority shall continue to consult through the combined Hui-a-Hapu on a regular basis during the design and construction stages over matters of importance to tangata whenua including any sites of significance, geothermal areas and the Waikato River crossing, the approach to restoration and rehabilitation including the use of locally sourced plant species and design features.

Silt and Sediment

~~18. A sediment and siltation management plan shall be prepared prior to construction commencing to address stormwater management during construction and after completion of the proposed work. The work shall be designed to prevent sediment laden water runoff entering any natural watercourse. The siltation plan shall identify:~~

- ~~○ Specific methods for preventing silt and sediment entering waterways;~~
- ~~○ Measures to safeguard against sediment laden discharges and other pollutants entering the Waikato River and ephemeral streams;~~
- ~~○ Contingency measures to ensure in the event that any silt or sediment enters waterways that remedial measures are implemented;~~

Geothermal Features

~~19. A plan shall be prepared in consultation with Contact Energy, Department of Conservation, tangata whenua and Environment Waikato for the protection of and mitigation of adverse effects on significant geothermal features within the designation boundary during and after construction:~~

~~20. Matters to be addressed in the plan shall include the minimisation of the construction width, minimising operational effects, such as the avoidance of stormwater discharge into active geothermal areas, and the planting of batters with appropriate native species.~~

Access

~~21. All private access onto local roads that are affected by the ETA shall be reconstructed to at least the equivalent of existing standards.~~

Landscape

~~22. A plan shall be prepared by a suitably qualified and experienced landscape architect to maintain and enhance landscape and amenity values along the ETA route:~~

~~23. The plan shall be prepared in consultation with the Department of Conservation, tangata whenua and adjacent property owners:~~

~~24. The plan shall:~~

- ~~○ Be consistent with the landscape design concepts contained in the plan entitled *Taupō District Council Proposed East Taupō Arterial: Indicative*~~

Landscape Mitigation Measures Plan No. 265562.01 October 2002 attached as Schedule D:

- Identify existing vegetation affected by the proposed works which, where practicable, is to be retained. This vegetation shall be protected during construction.
- Include a schedule of species to be planted, including botanical name, average plant size at time of planting, planting density and average mature height for each.
- Contain planting specifications.
- Contain measures to be undertaken to ensure the soil during earthworks and rehabilitate the soil profile so as to provide a viable growing medium for the planted trees.
- Provide for a maintenance period of no less than five years. Inspection of the landscaping is to be undertaken at two and five years following completion of the initial planting to confirm that the landscaping has been completed, and that the plants have become established. Where remedial works are required to be undertaken, such works shall be undertaken within six months of the inspection. This inspection regime shall also apply to replacement planting that is required following the initial inspection.

25. The plan shall provide for:

- The integration of the proposed works into the surrounding landscape.
- The appreciation of vistas of Lake Taupō and the central plateau along the ETA route and at a rest area.

26. The plan shall be implemented during the first planting season following completion of the stage construction works providing climatic conditions are suitable; otherwise at the first practicable opportunity thereafter. Following completion of planting, the Requiring Authority shall submit to the Council a report by the landscape architect on the implementation of the landscape plan.

27. Where practicable, any planting utilising native plants shall use plants genetically sourced from the ecological district.

28. All planting within the road reserve shall be maintained to usual Council standards after the expiry of the specific maintenance period identified within the plan.

Noise

29. ~~The project shall, as a minimum standard, be designed and constructed to achieve compliance with Transit NZ's *Guidelines for the Management of Road Traffic Noise - State Highway Improvements, December 1999*.~~

30. ~~Prior to the commencement of construction of a stage or stages of the proposed work a Noise Mitigation Strategy shall be prepared by a suitably qualified and experienced noise consultant and submitted to the Council. The strategy shall describe the methods by which noise generated by traffic using the road within the designation will be able to comply with the specified noise limits.~~

31. ~~The Strategy shall include:~~

- ~~○ A plan showing the location of:~~
 - ~~▪ all existing residential buildings, hospitals or educational facilities; and~~
 - ~~▪ any land areas to the west of the ETA alignment that the provisions of the Taupō Proposed or Operative District Plans have indicated, prior to the commencement of construction of the relevant stage or stages, development for residential purposes which are located within or in the vicinity of the designation boundaries and that will potentially experience increased noise levels as a result of the operation of the new road.~~
- ~~○ Details of a comprehensive ambient noise survey for the locations identified on the plan. The purpose of the survey shall be to determine the current ambient sound levels for each location on which the Transit Guidelines design levels shall be based.~~
- ~~○ Details of the noise mitigation measures that will be used to ensure that noise from traffic using the roads within the designation shall comply with the specified noise limit for the areas identified in the plan.~~
- ~~○ The assessment of any revised noise standards at the time of construction/operation of the road (e.g. revised Transit Guidelines, District Plan criteria, National Standards) and the practicality of achieving the relevant updated standard.~~

32. ~~The Requiring Authority shall ensure that construction noise does not exceed the requirements of the New Zealand Standard NZS 6803:1999 *Construction Noise*.~~

Construction noise will be measured in accordance with New Zealand Standard NZS 6801:1999 *Measurement of Environmental Sound*, and assessed in accordance with New Zealand Standard NZS 6802:1999 *Assessment of Environmental Noise*.

33. A construction noise plan shall be prepared which describes the methods by which noise associated with the construction the work will be managed to comply with Condition 32. In particular the plan shall identify:

- The location of any acoustic barriers to be installed prior to the commencement of the main construction works;
- Methods of managing noise;
- Noise monitoring methods, including details of methods, equipment, location and frequency.

34. Construction works shall at all times be undertaken in accordance with the plan:

Dust

35. The Requiring Authority shall prepare a Dust Management Plan including the use of the following methods in order to avoid and minimise dust nuisance from the proposed works:

- Management procedures to control construction plant movements over dry areas and to restrict them to controlled haul routes;
- Undertaking earthworks in a staged manner to minimise the total area of disturbed earth exposed at anytime;
- The application of water to the working areas to maintain adequate moisture contents within the surface soils;
- The application of dust suppressants to areas of completed works until final shaping and topsoiling occurs;
- Mitigation measures to be undertaken to minimise dust in order to protect the existing transmission line (Bunnythorpe – Wairakei A 220kV line) including the basis upon which the monitoring of dust levels will be determined and any necessary insulator washings undertaken;

36. Control measures shall be in place to ensure that any vehicles leaving the designated site do not deposit soil or other debris on public roads. Any such

material deposited on any public road shall be cleaned up as soon as practicably possible at the Requiring Authorities expense.

37. The Requiring Authority shall ensure that dust migration is visually monitored continuously during earthworks operations on working days and daily during dry periods on non-working days.

38. The Requiring Authority shall have contingency measures in place to ensure that, in the event of any dust nuisance arising, immediate remedial measures are implemented.

Network Utilities - General

39. The Requiring Authority shall consult with network utility operators prior to submitting the Outline Plan, to ensure that measures are adopted to mitigate potential impacts of the Proposed Work on network utility operations within or directly adjacent to the boundaries of the designation. The Outline Plan shall include any mitigation measures agreed between the Requiring Authority and network utility operators within the designation boundaries, or as otherwise specified in conditions on this designation.

40. The Requiring Authority shall specify best practice techniques for construction to ensure that all network utility operations and the Council's infrastructure, which includes the spray irrigation area, is protected and that public safety is ensured.

41. Requiring Authority shall appoint a liaison person to liaise and consult with all Network Utility Operators, and the Council in relation to the spray irrigation area, on all matters related to the impact of the Proposed Work on their infrastructure.

United Networks Limited

42. The Requiring Authority shall give notice to United Networks in relation to any part of the Proposed Work which may affect United Networks' infrastructure as follows:

a. At least twelve (12) months' notice before the commencement of any works which may require the relocation or reconstruction of any of United Networks' infrastructure.

b. At least six (6) months' notice before the commencement of any works which may result in a potential variation in either the final surface cover of an underground service or clearance to an overhead service or which may adversely affect access either permanently or temporarily to any such infrastructure.

~~43.-The Requiring Authority shall consult with United Networks during the detailed design of the Proposed Work and before the Outline Plan is finalised and shall make any reasonable changes requested by United Networks to the relevant design; plans and methodologies to ensure that any adverse effects on United Networks' infrastructure are avoided, remedied or mitigated, including ensuring uninterrupted supply of network utility services; provision for future infrastructure and continuous access to infrastructure for maintenance and upgrading throughout the construction and implementation of the designation works.~~

~~44.-The Requiring Authority shall ensure that adverse effects of the designation works on United Networks' infrastructure are avoided, remedied or mitigated, in consultation with United Networks. All costs associated with avoiding, remedying, or mitigating the effects on United Networks' infrastructure shall be borne by the Requiring Authority. Such costs shall include (but not be limited to) all costs associated with relocation or replacement of infrastructure (including the costs of obtaining any replacement infrastructure or any new sites on which to locate the infrastructure); costs of obtaining any designations or easements over existing, relocated or replacement infrastructure, costs relating to any alterations required to be made to the infrastructure as a result of the works, costs incurred by United Networks associated with obtaining any statutory consents and ensuring continued compliance with any statutory requirements or conditions of consent and all costs incurred by United Networks associated with the failure by the Requiring Authority to avoid, remedy or mitigate any adverse effects.~~

Transpower New Zealand Limited

~~45.-The Requiring Authority shall prepare a Transmission Line Management Plan in conjunction with Transpower New Zealand Limited to be submitted as part of the Outline Plan and be to the satisfaction of the Chief Executive Officer (or nominee); Taupō District Council. The Plan will have particular regard to the needs of Transpower with the objective of avoiding adverse effects on the Bunnythorpe – Wairakei A 220kV transmission line and ensuring Transpower can continue to maintain and operate its network at the existing level of service and give effect to the conditions specifically related to Transpower.~~

~~46.-The Requiring Authority shall ensure that existing access arrangements to Transpower transmission towers are retained. Where the Requiring Authority requires or causes a change in access arrangements, then alternative arrangements shall be made (to the satisfaction of Transpower) to provide safe 24~~

hour four wheel drive access to the base of transmission towers, including during construction of the Proposed Work.

47. No earthworks greater than 300 mm in depth shall be undertaken within 6 metres of the outer edge of the visible foundation of any Transpower transmission tower without the provision of a retaining structure. The construction of all retaining structures within 6 metres of the outer edge of the visible foundation of a transmission tower shall require the consent of Transpower.

48. Prior to submitting the Outline Plan, the Requiring Authority shall obtain Transpower's approval in the event that earthworks greater than 300mm in depth within 6m of the outer edge of the visible foundation of a Transpower transmission tower or greater than 3 metres in depth between 6 and 12 metres from the outer edge of a Transpower transmission tower, or where any works are proposed that could create an unstable batter and which may adversely affect a Transpower transmission tower.

49. All construction works shall comply with the following standards and conditions:

- All mobile plant and machinery operated in relation to the Proposed Work shall maintain a minimum clearance of 4 metres from Transpower conductors at all times.
- No temporary buildings, scaffolding or stationary plant shall be located within 8 metres of any Transpower conductor.
- All earthworks (including stockpiles) underneath Transpower conductors shall be managed to maintain a minimum clearance of 7.5 metres at all times.

50. The Requiring Authority shall provide suitable vehicle collision protection for potentially affected Transpower transmission line towers. The standard of protection is to be agreed between the Requiring Authority and Transpower.

51. Any landscaping plantings shall be selected and located to ensure that no part of any vegetation will encroach into an area closer than 4 metres to any conductors of the transmission lines. The 4-metre clearance relates to vertical, horizontal and felling distance clearances. There is also a need to ensure plantings are kept clear of transmission line tower foundations.

52. Where the Proposed Work causes injurious affection (e.g. as a result of Transpower transmission line towers being relocated) the Requiring Authority shall ensure

appropriate easements are obtained for that section of the transmission line alteration.

Note 1: It should be noted that in future Transpower is proposing to operate the Bunnythorpe - Wairakei A 220kV line (BPE-WRK A) at a higher operating temperature (from 50°C to 90°C). This will increase the sag of the line, and when and where this occurs Transpower will be responsible for ensuring that the appropriate clearance distances are achieved. The Requiring Authority will be responsible for ensuring that the relevant established clearance distances are maintained through the course of the project.

Note 2: The Requiring Authority shall comply with New Zealand Electrical Code of Practice for Electrical Safety Distances (NZECP 34:2001).

Contact Energy Limited

53. The Requiring Authority will consult with Contact Energy Limited (Contact) throughout the design and construction stages of the Proposed Work and will invite Contact's participation in any cooperation/partnering meetings it holds during those stages.
54. The Requiring Authority will provide as part of the design and construction of the Proposed Work, at its cost, provision for the pipe and vehicle crossings specific in Schedule "B" attached.
55. The Requiring Authority will consent to placement of geothermal pipelines across the designated land other than as specified in Schedule "B" attached at the cost of the pipeline owner subject to the Requiring Authority approving the exact location and design and construction methods.
56. The Requiring Authority will ensure that the existence of the designation prior to construction does not preclude or limit geothermal development of the Tauhara Geothermal field pursuant to resource consents in existence on 26 June 2002.
57. The Requiring Authority will ensure that the existence of the Proposed Work and/or the designation does not preclude construction and operation of wells beneath the ground surface.
58. The Requiring Authority will ensure that the Proposed Work is designed and constructed to recognise the fact that it is being constructed over a Development Geothermal System, as defined in the Waikato Regional Policy Statement, and shall

~~recognise that the existence of the Proposed Work once constructed will not restrict future development of that geothermal system.~~

~~59.-The East Taupō Arterial Designation Plan for Stage 4 (Sheet 13) will be reduced in width so that it does not cover any land defined as the Wairakei Binary Plant "Site 3" as set out in the document *Wairakei Binary Plant Project Resource Consent Applications and Assessment of Environmental Effects*, October 1996 or the control building to the north of "Site 3".~~

~~60.-The Requiring Authority will ensure that not less than 33 metres clearance is provided at all times between construction works for the Proposed Work and geothermal well WK303 located at BOP Circuit N 603593.3, BOP Circuit E 267950.4, NZMG Location N 62891599.312, NZMG Location E 2779812.14, unless a lesser distance is agreed to by the owner of the Wairakei Power Station.~~

~~61.-The Requiring Authority will investigate the cost and practicality of constructing one or more elevated structures on which the Proposed Work will be placed in those areas where it passes through all or part of the Wairakei Power Station land compared with the use of an embankment type support for the ETA in that area and shall adopt one or more of the elevated structures where the comparison indicates that the elevated structure or structures are:~~

~~a.—materially less costly after comparing the overall cost benefit ratio for Stage 4; and~~

~~b.—are practically and legally feasible.~~

~~62.-If the Requiring Authority determines under the preceding condition that an embankment type design is appropriate, it will ensure that it incorporates access for pipe work and for vehicular traffic across the line of the ETA of the same extent and utility as was in existence on 26 June 2002.~~

~~63.-The Requiring Authority will ensure at its cost that any part of the Proposed Work crossing the site of the Wairakei Power Station other than by way of an elevated bridge structure is bounded by a security fence precluding public access to the Power Station site.~~

~~64.-The Requiring Authority will ensure that construction and operation of the Proposed Work does not restrict the continued use of steam vents located on the Wairakei Power Station site and in existence on 26 June 2002.~~

65.-The Requiring Authority will ensure that dust, vibration, or other construction effects do not interrupt electricity production at Wairakei Power Station at any time during construction of the Proposed Work.

66.-The Requiring Authority will provide as part of the design and construction of the Waikato River bridge provision for geothermal pipes to be attached to the bridge structure, subject to agreement over the design, construction, positioning and apportioning of the extra costs.

Department of Conservation

67.-The Requiring Authority shall involve a representative of the Department of Conservation (DoC) in design discussions for Stages 2 (geothermal sections only), 3 and 4 to ensure that measures to mitigate potential impacts of the Proposed Work on land administered by DoC are included in the Outline Plan. The Outline Plan shall include those mitigation measures agreed between DoC and the Requiring Authority within the designation boundaries.

68.-Within one month of the designation being confirmed, the Requiring Authority shall appoint a representative that will be its principal contact person in regard to matters relating to DoC interests.

69.-The Requiring Authority shall inform DoC in writing at least one month prior to any transfer of this designation (pursuant to section 180 of the RMA) or alteration to this designation (pursuant to section 181 of the RMA).

70.-Following approval of the Outline Plan the effective width of designation across Broadlands Road Scenic Reserve shall be reduced so that it is no greater than 45 metres. On all other areas administered by DoC the Outline Plan shall specify the land required to facilitate construction and operation of the proposed work. The area required shall be kept to the minimum necessary to enable the proposed work (this being a two lane State Highway specification road) to be undertaken. The remaining area shall be freed of the requirements of the designation at this point. All physical works are to be located within this corridor including sediment and storm water control facilities and the land identified as S, T and U on the “approved” plans shall not be disturbed during construction.

71.-The requirement for land to facilitate a roundabout at the Broadlands Road intersection shall have no physical impact on Broadlands Road Scenic Reserve.

72.-The Requiring Authority shall, in consultation with DoC and consistent with the DoC Track Service Standards for “walking tracks”, ensure that public walking and cycling

access is maintained along the Aratiatia Walkway where the new road will effectively sever the existing track:

73. 76. An ecological assessment is to be prepared and circulated to DoC for the area to be disturbed in the TH2 gully (Waikato River Conservation Area):

77. No stormwater is to be directly discharged into the Broadlands Road Scenic Reserve or the TH2 gully. In addition, the Requiring Authority shall implement modern stormwater management practices as far as is practicable to minimise the discharge of untreated stormwater to all other natural waterways:

78. No stockpile, dump or borrow sites are to be located on areas administered by DoC:

Mighty River Power

79. The Requiring Authority shall consult with Mighty River Power Limited (Mighty River Power) throughout the design and construction stages of the proposed Waikato River bridge:

80. The Requiring Authority shall consult with Mighty River Power prior to undertaking any associated works, including landscaping works, that are proposed within the land subject to operating easements shown on Section 1 SO 61115..

81. The Requiring Authority shall obtain Mighty River Power's agreement that the construction and function of the proposed Waikato River bridge crossing will be undertaken in a manner that does not detrimentally obstruct water flow and/or compromise Mighty River Power's rights to store water within its operating easements, or its ability to efficiently operate the Waikato hydro system:
