ROLLOVER OF NEW ZEALAND TRANSPORT AGENCY DESIGNATIONS WITH MODIFICATION

Please find attached a notice requesting the rollover of the New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) state highway designations.

In accordance with Schedule 1, Part 1, Schedule 4 of the Resource Management Act 1991, NZTA requests that Taupo District Council roll over the designations for State Highways 1, 5, 30, 32, 41, and 46 with modifications, into the Proposed Plan. The modifications sought include updating the designation purpose to be consistent with other district plans across New Zealand and ensuring the state highway network designations align with existing legal and operational road corridors. These modifications are discussed further in the enclosed notice.

In addition, NZTA have lodged a Notice of Requirement (NoR) as part of Council's District Plan Review to designate State Highway 47, which is an existing, formed and operational state highway. When this NoR is confirmed, it should be recorded in the Proposed District Plan schedule of designations with the New Zealand Transport Agency as the requiring authority.

NZTA has prepared geospatial maps to reflect the proposed modifications to the designation boundaries for State Highways 1, 5, 30, 32, 41, and 46; and the boundaries of the designation associated with the Notice of Requirement (NoR) for State Highway 47. These geospatial shapefiles are supplied with the attached notice.

NZTA considers that the proposed modifications will have the same effect on people and the environment as the existing state highway designations. These modifications will simplify the administration of the NZTA designations within the Proposed Plan.
