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Hi Christle

Thank you for getting in touch regarding the District Plan review of the Designations held by Unison Networks Limited.

We have reviewed the information supplied by you and comment as follows:-

1. Unison wishes to retain **all** of its current Designations which are recorded on the District Plan including those provided in your 29 August letter.
2. Would it be possible to expand the names of the Substations to include the title they are known by within Unison as follows:-

Waikato Street Substation – **Runanga**

Marshall Ave Substation – **Taupo South**

Rakanui Road Substation – **Centennial**

Unison Networks Electricity Distribution Substation & Depot – **Fleet Street**

Centennial Drive Substation – **Taupo East**

3. In relation to the **Marshall Avenue (Taupo South) substation** we request:-

- a. Removal of condition 1 - The existing screen planting on site be retained and replaced as necessary.

Unison received a request from the neighbouring property owner to remove the existing plantings as they had become overgrown and were obstructing their sunlight. Unison was happy to accommodate this request to benefit the neighbouring property owner.

- b. Amend condition 2 – That weekly inspections and maintenance be undertaken to minimise any adverse impacts of graffiti on on-site structures.

Unison requests this condition be amended to **fortnightly** inspections as Unison has not experienced issues with graffiti for some years. The Substation is currently inspected each fortnight as part of Unison's routine inspection program and checks for graffiti are undertaken at that time. Any graffiti issues are raised for resolving at that time if required.
