DECLARING PART OF LAKE TERRACE AND HOROMATANGI STREET AS PEDESTRIAN MALLS

Taupō District Council gives notice that at its meeting on Tuesday, May 11, and in consideration to submissions received on the Statement of Proposal, that part of Lake Terrace between Tongariro Street and Ruapehu Street, and the eastern leg of Horomatangi Street intersection with Titiraupenga Street has been declared a 'Pedestrian Mall' under Section 336 of the Local Government Act 1974; and to prohibit at all times the driving, riding, or parking of any vehicle, or the riding of any animal on the pedestrian mall, except for the following:

- Cyclists (and riders of wheeled recreational devices, including motorised and e-scooters)
- Emergency Service vehicles
- Authorised vehicles, with prior permission from Taupō District Council

Any person may appeal to the Environment Court against the declaration under section 336(3) of the Local Government Act 1974. Appeals to the Environment Court need to be made by June 21, 2021, or within such further time as the Environment Court may allow. The appeal must be made and determined by the Environment Court in accordance with the Resource Management Act 1991 and any regulation made under that Act. The Environment Court may quash or affirm the declaration or affirm the declaration with modification. The decision of the Environment Court is final.
