TO GRANT A LEASE OF PART OF THE ARMED CONSTABULARY PARK TO YOUTHTOWN INCORPORATED SUBJECT TO SECTION 54(1)(C) OF THE RESERVES ACT.

The new lease of around 1113 metres square is for a larger area than the previous lease that began in 2008. It would allow Youthtown to construct a new basketball half court and small administrative building so they can free up their existing building for students' programmes.
