PUBLIC CONSULTATION **ON TAUPŌ DISTRICT SPEED** **MANAGEMENT PLAN AND PROPOSED** **CHANGES TO SPEED LIMITS**

Taupō District Council is proposing changes to the speed limits on some of our roads. These will be introduced through a Speed Management Plan for our district, which will bring together strategies on improving infrastructure on local roads. It will also outline our approach to setting new speed limits over the next ten years.

Our Speed Management Plan responds to national priorities of creating safe liveable urban streets, reducing serious accidents, and improving the safety experience for all road users.

We are seeking feedback on two topics. Firstly, the approach we are taking to set consistent speed limits across the district. Secondly, we are consulting on the first group of proposed speed limit changes we want to make. These changes are district wide, and have been grouped into the following areas:

- 30km/h speed limit outside Schools
- Rural District Roads
- Taupō Central
- Taupō and its surrounds
- Kinloch
- Turangi
- Whareroa
- Eastern Bays
