IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act)

AND

IN THE MATTER of an application by Taupo Rugby Football Club Incorporated for a new Club Licence pursuant to Section 100 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 in respect of the premises situated at **57 Delany Drive**, **Taupo**, and known as "Taupo Rugby & Sports Club"

The Application:

This is an application by Taupo Rugby Football Club Incorporated for a new club licence in respect of premises situated at 57 Delany Drive, Taupo and known as Taupo Rugby & Sports Club. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 2nd June 2023. The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a Sports Club.

The application was duly advertised in the Taupo Times newspaper on 2 June 2023 and 9 June 2023 and no objections were received. Display of the public notice has been carried out in the terms of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the applicant and no objections were lodged by any members of the public.

Reasons for the Decision:

The applicant appears to be a suitable entity to hold a Club Licence and must put processes in place to ensure the Licence does not expire before renewal again.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health reports raise no matters in opposition.

The Decision:

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in the Act and we grant the applicant a Club Licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is a member of the club or an authorised customer or visitor who is on the premises at the invitation of a club member within the definition of section 60(3) of the Act.

The licence shall be subjected to specific conditions as detailed in the attached licence.

CLUB LICENCE

Sections 21 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 <u>TAUPO RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB INCORPORATED</u> is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **57 Delany Drive**, **Taupo** and known as **Taupo Rugby & Sports Club**, for consumption on the premises, to any person who-

- a) is a member of the club; or
- b) is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
- c) is a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members; or
- d) is on the premises at the invitation of an authorised visitor who is also on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the club in accordance with Sub-Part 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: **Monday to Sunday** from 12.00 noon to 11.30pm.
- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 3. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
- 5. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- 6. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
- 7. Whilst the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol no BYO alcohol may be consumed on the premises.
- 8. The Club must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read so as to be easily read by persons using the premises.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale, supply or consumption of alcohol is authorised in the premises generally. The premises situated at 57 Delany Drive, Taupo, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 25 May 2023.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCES

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the club. The entrance from the carpark located off Delany Drive, Taupo is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was renewed.

This licence expires on 26 June 2024 unless further renewed
