New Managers Certificate under Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Applicant: Wipapon Donpadcha

Please find attached below your Manager's Certificate that has been granted by the Taupō District Licensing Committee, along with copies of the relevant reports.

We wish to draw your attention to Section 214 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 which states:

214 Manager to be on duty at all times and responsible for compliance

(1) Except as provided in Section 215, a manager must be on duty at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied to the public on any licensed premises.

(2) A manager on duty on any licensed premises is responsible for—

(a) the compliance with and enforcement of—

(i) the provisions of this Act; and

(ii) the conditions of the licence in force for the premises; and

(b) the conduct of the premises with the aim of contributing to the reduction of alcohol-related harm.

(3) At all times while a manager is on duty on any licensed premises, the full name of the manager must be prominently displayed inside the premises so as to be easily read by people using the premises; and the person named as manager at any time is to be treated for the purposes of this Act as the manager at that time.

(4) At all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied on licensed premises the licensee must take all reasonable steps to enable the manager to comply with this section.

Your Manager's Certificate does not need to be displayed in the premises license but must be available for viewing by the Police or a Licensing Inspector. This may be checked as part of random compliance inspections by either the Police or Alcohol Licensing Inspectors.

The Application:

This is an application by Wipapon Donpadcha for a new Managers Certificate pursuant to Section 219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 10th April 2026.

Reasons for the Decision

1. The applicant holds the Licence Controller Qualification and is employed in licensed premises.
2. The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested their understanding of their responsibilities as a Manager.
3. Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the grant of the certificate **subject to an undertaking**. Accordingly, the application can be dealt with on the papers.
4. The application and supporting information satisfies the Committee that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in Section 222 of the Act have been met.

Decision of the Taupō District Licensing Committee:

The District Licensing Committee Commissioner, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 approves the application by Wipapon Donpadcha for a Manager's Certificate.

The certificate is valid for the period of twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.

Managers Certificate

Section 217 - Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Wipapon Donpadcha

Certificate Number: **20/CERT/3530/2026**

is authorised to manage any licensed premises in respect of which a licence is in force.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to fees and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of managers' certificates, this certificate shall continue in force:

- a) Either:
 - 1. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - 2. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of twelve months after the day it was issued; but
- b) If an application for the renewal of the certificate is duly made before the certificate would otherwise expire, either:
 - 1. Until the close of the period of three years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - 2. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of four years after the day it was issued.

The applicant has provided a signed undertaking that they will not utilise their Manager's Certificate at any licensed premises other than Thai Central Limited in Taupō without written approval of an Alcohol Licencing Inspector and the Taupō Police.

This Managers Certificate expires on
