DECISION OF THE TAUPŌ DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

The Application:

This is an application by Rolima Mangilin Pecho for a new Managers Certificate pursuant to Section 219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 8th July 2026.

Reasons for the Decision

1. The applicant holds the Licence Controller Qualification and is employed in licensed premises.
2. The Licensing Inspector has provided a report outlining the applicant's experience in controlling licensed premises and has tested their understanding of their responsibilities as a Manager.
3. Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, **however the Police conditionally oppose the grant of the certificate as they believe the applicant has limited experience in the role.**
4. The Act requires that the DLC **must have regard** to **"any experience, in particular recent experience"**. The Police are correct in their suggestion that six months is the norm expected (for high risk premises and 3 months in low risk premises).
5. This applicant has 5 months and 3 weeks experience with her current employer and importantly much of that relates to age verification and intoxication assessment of customers. She also offers an undertaking to only use the certificate at Pak n save Taupo. She is, in fact, more suitably experienced than many supermarket candidates that come before us.
6. Accordingly, the application can be dealt with on the papers.
7. The application and supporting information satisfies the Committee that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in Section 222 of the Act have been met.

Decision of the Taupō District Licensing Committee:

The District Licensing Committee Commissioner, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 approves the application by Rolima Mangilin Pecho for a Manager's Certificate.

The certificate is valid for the period of twelve months from the date the certificate is issued.

Managers Certificate

Section 217 - Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Rolima Mangilin Pecho

Certificate Number: **20/CERT/3583/2026**

is authorised to manage any licensed premises in respect of which a licence is in force.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to fees and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of managers' certificates, this certificate shall continue in force:

- a) Either:
 - 1. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - 2. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of twelve months after the day it was issued; but
- b) If an application for the renewal of the certificate is duly made before the certificate would otherwise expire, either:
 - 1. Until the close of the period of three years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - 2. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of four years after the day it was issued.

The applicant has provided a signed undertaking that they will not utilise their Manager's Certificate at any licensed premises other than Pak n Save Taupo in Taupō without written approval of an Alcohol Licencing Inspector and the Taupō Police.

This Managers Certificate expires on

27 August 2027
