The Application:

This is an application by TMGH Jolly Limited Partnership for an On Licence in respect of a conveyance situated at Berth 11, Taupo Boat Harbour, 65 Redoubt Street, Taupo, known as "Levante". It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 4th June 2026. The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a Conveyance.

The application was duly advertised in the newspaper and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Display of the public notice has been carried out in the terms of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the licensee and no objections were lodged by any members of the public.

Reasons for the Decision:

The applicant appears to be a responsible entity to hold an ON licence and a certificated manager will oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health reports raise no matters in opposition.

The Decision:

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in the Act and we grant the applicant an On Licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.

The licence shall be subjected to specific conditions as detailed in the attached licence.

On Licence for Conveyance

Section 14 to 16, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **TMGH JOLLY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the vessel known as "**Levante**" based at Berth 11, Taupo Boat Harbour, 65 Redoubt Street, Taupo, and journeying on Lake Taupo, to any person present on the vessel and to allow the consumption of alcohol on the conveyance by any such person.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the vessel only on the following days and hours during the period of any scheduled cruise: **Monday to Sunday from 8.00am to 12.00 midnight.**
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the vessel.
3. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the vessel, at all times when the vessel is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of prominently displayed non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the vessel at all times the vessel is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
5. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the vessel is open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the vessel.
6. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the vessel.
7. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point-of-sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the vessel so as to be easily read by patrons attending the conveyance.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale, supply or consumption of alcohol is authorised in the conveyance generally. The **Choose an item.** based at, is more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 4th June 2026.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- a) Until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it is renewed.

This licence expires on 21 July 2027 unless further renewed
