# **Notice of Renewal of Club Licence**

Section 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

To: The Taupo Aero Club Incorporated

Licence 20/CL/0038/2023 replacing licence 20/CL/0038/2020

The Club Licence in respect of the premises situated at 1075 Anzac Memorial Drive (Private), Taupo known as "The Taupo Aero Club" is renewed.

The present conditions of the licence shall continue to apply.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, the licence continues in force—

- · until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it is renewed.

The period for which the licence is renewed is 3 years expiring on

#### **CLUB LICENCE**

Sections 21 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 <u>THE TAUPO AERO CLUB INCORPORATED</u> is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **1075 Anzac Memorial Drive (Private)**, **Taupo** and known as **The Taupo Aero Club**, for consumption on the premises, to any person who-

- a) is a member of the club; or
- b) is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
- c) is a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members; or
- d) is on the premises at the invitation of an authorised visitor who is also on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the club in accordance with Sub-Part 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

### **CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: Monday to Thursday from 4.00pm to 9.00pm; Friday from 2.00pm to 11.00pm; & Saturday and Sunday from 12.00 noon to 11.00pm
- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises
- 3. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
- 5. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises
- 6. Whilst the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol no BYO alcohol may be consumed on the premises.
- 7. The Club must display:
  - a) At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
  - b) A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons using the premises

## THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale, supply or consumption of alcohol is authorised in the premises generally including the outdoor areas. The premises situated at 1075 Anzac Memorial Drive, Taupo, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 22 August 2019.

### **DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCES**

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Anzac Memorial Drive, Taupo is designated as the principal entrance.

#### **DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- a) until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it is renewed.

This licence expires on 30 September 2026 unless further renewed
