The Application

- Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours: Saturday 6 April 2024 from 9.00am to 1.00pm; and Saturday 4 May 2024 from 9.00am to 1.00pm.
- 2. Only 700ml size sealed glass bottles are to be sold for off-site consumption, and No tastings are to be done.
- A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the stall.
- 4. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point-of-sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
 - b. A copy of the licence is to be attached to stall so as to be easily read by people attending the licensed area.

Off Site Special Licence

Section 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012
