The Application

This is an application by Mr Benjamin Bisley on behalf of Tauhara College for an on site Special Licence pursuant to Section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for the Tauhara College 50th Jubilee Dinner. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 11th May 2026.

Reasons for the Decision

The applicant appears to be a responsible entity to hold a Special Licence, and a certificated manager will oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

No designation is required as the exclusive use of the premises will not be the sale supply and consumption of alcohol.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health Representative reports raise no matters in opposition.

The Decision

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in the Act and we grant the applicant a Special Licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): Tauhara College 50th Jubilee Dinner.

The licence shall be subjected to mandatory and discretionary conditions as detailed in the attached licence.

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Mr Benjamin Bisley on behalf of Tauhara College** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 101 Invergarry Road, Taupo, and known as Tauhara College for consumption on the premises, to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **Tauhara College 50th Jubilee Dinner.**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through managers or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: **Saturday 17 October 2026 from 6.00pm to 11.00pm.**
2. Alcohol serves: A maximum of two alcoholic drinks can be sold to one person at any one time.
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
4. Intoxicated persons will not be served and must be removed from the venue, and minors must not be served alcohol.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of prominently displayed non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Food should be actively promoted.
7. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times at the bar facility, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
8. The Licensee must provide free information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
9. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises,
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.

DURATION

This licence is only in force as specified in Condition 1.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The licensed premises known as "Tauhara College" situated at 101 Invergarry Road, Taupo, is more precisely identified as outlined in the Event Site Plan provided with the application, as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 11th May 2026
