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STANDARD PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. Taupō District Council (“**we**”) requires all tankers drawing water to have a suitable backflow prevention device fitted to avoid contamination of the network supply.
2. The only areas permitted for water tanker filling are:

Acacia Bay	650 Acacia Bay Road - outside Wastewater Treatment Plant
Kinloch	Opposite 118 Kinloch Rd
Mangakino	End Boundary Line 1 Lake Road (Lake Maraetai end)
Turangi	30 Te Rangitukehu Street (Industrial Area)

3. We may revoke or suspend this permit at any time if we reasonably believe your exercise of it impacts our ability to provide the necessary level of water services to the community. You will be notified of such revocation or suspension.

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SPECIAL CONDITIONS/FURTHER INFORMATION

1. This permit is valid only once your application is approved and that approval is communicated to you.
2. You must not use the hydrants except in an emergency.
3. You must supply all equipment to get access to and draw water from the tanker filling point, including metered hydrant stand, fittings and hoses, all of which must be in good condition.
4. We will invoice you monthly for the total meter reading of the month and payment must be made on or by the 20th of the following month.
5. You no longer need to provide photographic evidence of meter readings. This is now recorded electronically by the new Water Fill Station Fobs.
