New Year's Eve set to light up Taupō skies

Taupō District will be celebrating the New Year in style with two rounds of fireworks planned to welcome in 2013. The fireworks will be visible from many vantage points around Taupō.

This year Taupō District Council is putting on two rounds of fireworks for the community to enjoy. The build up to the New Year will begin at 9.30pm with music on the Lakefront.

Taupō residents can watch from their homes or the Lakefront. The fireworks will be launched from around the middle of the Lakefront near the Taupō town centre.

The first event will be early for children and families to enjoy. The Twilight Mini Bang is at 10.00pm. It will last for five minutes and is a great way for kids to see the fireworks at an earlier time.

The second display is at midnight and will go for about ten minutes. This is the more spectacular show – the Big Bang – and is for those who want to celebrate the arrival of 2013 on the dot.

A liquor ban will be in place and will be enforced.
