SPECIAL CONDITIONS (TDC TO COMPLETE)

1. The Company shall purchase at its expense a metered hydrant stand and such hydrant stand shall be the only device used to access the network.
2. On the last day of each month the Company shall produce a digital photo showing the hydrant stand' meter reading and the date on which the photo was taken and shall send that photo to the Council to be received no later than the 5th of the following month.
3. TDC will invoice the Company monthly for the total meter reading of the month. (Present meter reading less previous month's reading). Payment to be made on the 20th of the following month.
4. Failure to meet any of these conditions could result in the revoking of this arrangement.
5. The use of other hydrants is only permitted by specific approval of the Network Operations Engineer whose decision on an application in this regard shall be final.

NO TAKING OF WATER FROM HYDRANTS IS PERMISSIBLE WITHOUT A CURRENT PERMIT**

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STANDARD PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. Taupō District Council requires all tankers drawing water to have a suitable backflow prevention device fitted in order to avoid contamination of the network supply.
2. The following areas are the only areas permitted for water tanker filling:

Taupō Area	County Avenue
	O/S 9-13 Mahoe St (Downers Yard)
Centennial Area	Rakaunui Rd (outside street number 100 – electrical compound with dedicated filling location in ground)
Acacia Bay	O/S 6 Winston St
Kinloch	Opp 122 Kinloch Rd
Mangakino	O/S 1 Lake Road (Lake Maraetai end)
Turangi	Industrial Area; 30 Te Rangitukehu Street
Other location as agreed with the Network Operations Engineer and clearly specified below.	

Tanker filling at any other location is prohibited.

3. TDC may revoke or suspend this permit at any time if there is impact on the water supply which could affect the level of service to the existing community, due to any cause whatsoever. Such revocation or suspension shall take effect from the date and time that TDC notifies the Contact Person via any of the contact mechanisms listed in this permit.
