The school holidays run from April 17 to 28 and at Taupō Library and Museum there's something on every week day throughout, apart from Easter and ANZAC public holidays. Plus, all our activities are free!

These include guided activities like drama games, Easter bunny craft and making bird feeders as well as a visit from The Pet Shop animals and self-guided activities including a

dinosaur hunt and old school games.

In Turangi it's all about music, with musical demonstrations, toy drum and maraca making, and karaoke time. In Mangakino our kids can learn varn craft, watch a movie, or enjoy some colouring in.
