FEES AND CHARGES

As part of our Long-term Plan consultation, we're seeking feedback on some changes we are proposing for our fees and charges.

One of the changes we are proposing is to remove the 'rural dog other' category so all dogs, other than working dogs, are classified the same and will pay the same registration fee. We are also looking to reward dog owners who register their dogs by July 1 by offering a reduced rate.

Other proposed changes are to increase our pool entry fees as follows:

AC BATHS ENTRY FEE INCREASES:

- \$8 to \$10 for an adult;
- \$5 to \$6 for a senior/student;
- \$4 to \$5 child or under 5-year-old children, including a non-paying adult for supervision.

TURANGI AQUATIC CENTRE ENTRY FEE:

- \$4 to \$5 for an adult.

MANGAKINO POOL

- \$3.50 to \$4.50.
