### SWIMMERS GO TO GREAT LENGTHS IN TURANGI

Are you finding it too cold to get out and pound the pavement? Living in Turangi? Like to swim?

If you're a yes to all of these, why not take up the Margaret Sweeney Challenge.

The event is named after former Empire Games swimmer Margaret Sweeney, who on top of being a New Zealand breaststroke champion, and representing New Zealand at the games, was the first person to swim the length of Lake Taupo.

This aptly named test of endurance pits participants up against either 25km or 50km distances. This sounds daunting to say the least, however you do have two months to complete the 25km challenge and three months for the 50km. Regular visits are the way to go, so as long as you are putting in the time, you'll get there!

Turangi resident Bev Campbell found this out last year.

"I started late and had to play catch-up, so this year I'm getting in from day one. It's good to have a goal and a great incentive to get regular exercise," says Bev.
