## Notice of Renewal of On Licence

*Section 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012*

To: **Kinloch Lodge Holdings Limited**

Licence **20/ON/0170/2023** replacing licence **20/ON/0170/2020**.

The On Licence in respect of the premises situated at 261 Kinloch Road, Kinloch known as “**The Kinloch Club**” is renewed.

The present conditions of the licence shall continue to apply.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, the licence continues in force—

- until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it is renewed.

**ON LICENCE**

(for premises)

Sections 14 to 16, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **KINLOCH LODGE HOLDINGS LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 261 Kinloch Road, Kinloch and known as **The Kinloch Club**, to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
  - a. **Monday to Sunday from 10.00am to 1.00am the following day; and**
  - b. **At any time on any day to any person (guest) for the time being living on the premises, including any guest of that person, in whose room or unit alcohol has previously been placed (commonly known as a mini bar).**
2. No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day to any person other than a person who is on the premises to dine or is lodging on the premises.
3. The following parts of the premises are designated as a Supervised area: The Kinloch Lodge bar area.
4. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
5. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
7. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
8. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
9. The Licensee must display:
  - a) At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
  - b) At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol,
  - c) A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read.

**THE LICENCED PREMISES**

The sale, supply or consumption of alcohol is authorised in the premises generally including the clubhouse café & bar, and the lodge accommodation, bar and restaurant areas. The premises situated at 261 Kinloch Road, Kinloch, Taupo are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 8 December 2015.

**DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCES**

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrances into the Clubhouse Café & Bar, and also the Lodge reception/ lobby area are designated as the principal entrances.

**DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was renewed.

**This licence expires on 5 September 2026 unless further renewed**
