The Application

Reasons for the Decision

The reports of the Police and the Medical Officer of Health do not oppose this application.

The Decision

I am satisfied that the criteria of Section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 have been satisfactorily addressed by the applicant and the licence may issue subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following day and hours:

Saturday 4 December 2021 from 8.00am to 4.00pm.

- 2. While alcohol is being supplied as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
- 3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the stall.

4. The Licensee must display:

a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,

b. If so directed a copy of the licence is to be attached to stall so as to be easily read by people attending the licensed area.
