This is an application by **Stevie Rae Holdings Limited** for a Temporary Authority for on-licensed premises situated at 88 Wahi Road, Tokaanu, Turangi known as the “**Braxmere Restaurant.**”

There is a substantive ON licence in place 20/ON/0122/2021 expiring on the 9<sup>th</sup> of May 2024. Proposed take over date is 1 December 2021.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence including a signed sale and purchase agreement for the business.

Accordingly, the application is to be dealt with by the committee on the papers.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order **as long sole director, Raeleen Atareti Rihari’s ex-partner Steven Reweti Croft has no part of the business.**

Sufficient certificated manager/s must be appointed so as to have a certificated duty manager, on duty, at all times the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.

## **DECISION**

Subject to the above, the application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act has been met.

Section 136(5) of the Act says the person authorised by the order has for the purposes of this Act the same duties, obligations, and liabilities as the holder of the on-licence or off-licence concerned.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority with the existing conditions on the base licence continuing to apply:

- **The Order is to run for 3 months from the 1<sup>st</sup> of December 2021;**
- **The substantive ON Licence application must be lodged within 5 days of receiving the planning certificate from council.**
- **Steven Reweti Croft is to have no part in the sale, supply or consumption of alcohol under this Order for its duration.**
