

Taupo District Licensing Committee Special Licence – On Site

Section 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Greenstone Entertainment GP Limited** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at Riverside Park, Redoubt Street, Taupo, and known as Riverside Park, Taupo for consumption on the premises, to any person attending the following occasion or event: **Taupo Summer Concert**.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a managers or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Conditions:

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following day and hours: Saturday 4th day of February 2023; from 10:30am to 7:30pm with all sales to cease at 5.00pm. The Corporate Bar shall open at 11.00am and sales cease at 5.30pm.**
- Alcohol serves: A maximum of four serves per person, per transaction from 10.30am until to the reduction time of 4.00pm where drink serves are reduced to two serves per person per transaction until end of service.**
- Cans are to be de-pressurised at the point of sale from 10.30am.**
- Drinking water must be freely available at the bar and designated points in the venue for the duration of the event.
- A certificated manager must be on duty at all times within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be prominently displayed. Service staff must be fully trained and competent in server intervention techniques.
- Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- Alcohol may be sold of the following types, and containers, only: Only RTD's, beer, cider and wine to be sold under this licence. No free-pour spirits are permitted. Beverages are to be sold in cans or plastic cups.**
- All bar enclosures are to be Restricted Areas and the whole of the Corporate enclosure is to be a Supervised Area.**
- A One-Way Door (OWD) Policy applies, and no Pass-Outs (other than on medical grounds) are to be permitted.**
- All Crowd Controllers are to be COA qualified and experienced in working large scale events. All are to wear Hi-Vis vest to improve visibility.**
- The Licensee must display signage as follows:
At every point-of-sale detailing restriction on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.
- The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
- Police have the ability to require the further reduction of alcohol service sizes, or to request a closure of all, or any bar, at any time based on crowd behaviour. This request is to be evidence-based on hourly review meetings with Greenstone Entertainment GP Limited, the Taupo Police, the Taupo Licensing Inspector, and the Medical Officer of Health Representative.**

Duration

This licence is only in force as specified in Condition 1.

The licensed premises known as "Riverside Park, Taupo" situated at Riverside Park, Redoubt Street, Taupo, is more precisely identified as outlined in the "Event site plan" provided with the application, as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 31 October 2022.
