DECISION OF THE TAUPO DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

The Application

This is an application by **Mangakino District Services & Citizens Club Incorporated**, for an On-Site Special Licence pursuant to Section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for the **Big 3/ Pig Hunting Competition/ Lake Hop**. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 9th May 2023.

Reasons for the Decision

The applicant is a responsible entity, and a certificated manager will oversee these events.

The reports of the Police and the Medical Officer of Health do not oppose this application.

The Decision

I am satisfied that the criteria of Section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 have been satisfactorily addressed by the applicant and the licence may issue subject to the following conditions:


1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
Sunday 4 June 2023 from 2:00pm to 11:00pm (“The Big 3” Hunting Competition); Saturday 8 July 2023 from 4:00pm to 11:00pm (“The Lake Hop” car show community fundraiser); & Saturday 26 August 2023 from 2:00pm to 11:30pm (Mangakino District Services Club Pig Hunting Competition).
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.

6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:

- a. At every point-of-sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
- b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises,
- c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty,
- d. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.

The licensed premises known as the Mangakino District Services & Citizens Club situated at 46 Wairenga Road, Mangakino, is more precisely identified as outlined in the event site plan provided with the application, as received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 9 May 2023.
