There is a substantive ON licence in place 20/ON/0271/2018 that expires on the 5 July 2021.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence including a sale of purchase agreement.

Takeover is set for the 31st of March 2020

Accordingly, the application is to be dealt with by the committee on the papers.

## REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order.

## **DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act has been met.

Section 136(5) of the Act says the person authorised by the order has for the purposes of this Act the same duties, obligations, and liabilities as the holder of the on-licence or off-licence concerned.

We remind the applicant that a properly appointed certificated, or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority ON Licence with the existing conditions on the base licence continuing to apply:

- The Order is to run for 3 months from 31 March 2020 to the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2020;
- The substantive ON Licence application must be lodged within 5 working days of receipt of the planning certificate from council.
