This is an application by **SLT Enterprises Limited** for a Temporary Authority for premises situated at 150 Acacia Bay Road, Taupo to be known as "**Super Liquor Nukuhau.**"

There is a substantive OFF Licence 20/OFF/027/2021 expiring on the 10<sup>th</sup> of October 2024.

The application contains supporting documentary evidence indicating that a sale and purchase agreement has been completed for the business. Takeover date is scheduled for 20 April 2022.

Accordingly, the application is to be dealt with by the committee on the papers.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

Neither the New Zealand Police nor the Licensing Inspector express any concerns about the suitability of the applicant, nor do they oppose the granting of the order.

**We remind the applicant that a properly appointed experienced and certificated, must be on duty at all times when the premises is open for the sale and supply of alcohol.**

## **DECISION**

The application and supporting information satisfies us that the criteria we must have regard to as set out in s.136 of the Act has been met.

Section 136(5) of the Act says the person authorised by the order has for the purposes of this Act the same duties, obligations, and liabilities as the holder of the on-licence or off-licence concerned.

The applicant must comply with all the current conditions of licence including these two discretionary conditions that were deemed necessary for this location.

The District Licensing Committee, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 makes an order for a Temporary Authority OFF Licence with the existing conditions on the base licence continuing to apply:

- **The Order is to run for 3 months from the 20<sup>th</sup> of April 2022;**
- **The substantive OFF Licence application must be lodged within 5 days of receiving the planning certificate from council.**
