## LITTER BIN TRIAL TO GET UNDERWAY

A litter bin trial at the Kuratau boat ramp and at the river mouth is about to get underway over the summer period, following requests from residents.

The trial will run through the holiday period from December 16 – February 7. The bins are for litter and small recyclables only, so we request all household refuse be put out for kerbside collection or taken to the refuse transfer station as normal.

Other western lakeshore communities will remain 'pack it in, pack it out' areas in line with the neighbouring Department of Conservation reserves.



# **TURANGI-TONGARIRO BY-ELECTION**

A by-election period is underway for the Tongariro subdivision of the Turangi Tongariro Community Board.

Nominations are open until Monday December 23, with the voting period from Monday, January 27 to Tuesday, February 18.

The by-election follows the resignation of Mr Wally van der Aa.




### SUMMER FIRE RISK

As it gets drier over the summer months, please be aware of any flammable growth on your property.

Make sure you keep grass short particularly on empty sections - and clear away any scrub or litter such as fallen branches or leaves that could potentially fuel a fire.

If you have a problem with compliance on a neighbouring property, please talk directly with the landowner in the first instance.



# **KURATAU EROSION** CONTROL

A 'Living wall' erosion control solution has been installed at the Kuratau River mouth. The grassed wall provides a robust edge to the grassed reserve and is a more natural solution than hard structures like concrete.

Mesh 'socks' are placed over a compacted pumice base, which in turn is overlaid with a geotextile cloth designed to contain the pumice material behind the wall while still allowing water to pass through. The upper three tiers are filled with a soil/grass mix, the lower three tiers are filled with a scoria mix.

The system has been used on other lake shores around the world with great success, so we are hopeful that it will withstand the wave action that Taupō can generate during severe weather events.





# **EVERY DROP** COUNTS

As the district fills up with visitors and temperatures rise, demand for water increases dramatically.

Last year, we saw an increase in demand of 50 percent across the district in January and we are expecting a similar increase this year, so we are asking residents to act now to reduce demand.

Please only water your garden and lawn every second day (using the odds and evens system based on your street address). This applies to fixed sprinklers only. Hand held hoses can be used at any time.
